Wild Ohio

Corn Maze, Pumpkin Patch, Hayride and Horses!

Corn Maze: This year Cherry Ridge Farms is going wild for Ohio! We cut our corn maze in the shape of our beautiful state, and filled it full of tricky questions about the many animals that share this bountiful and diverse land with us. Get lost, have fun, and test your critter knowledge.

Pumpkin Patch: Native Ohio peoples cultivated pumpkins alongside corn, sunflowers, and hundreds of years before the settlers arrived. Visit our native cultures demonstration garden and explore the life cycle of pumpkins and some of the tools and techniques used by Ohio's first people.
